Forum Theme: High-end Asian Forum to Commemorate the 10th Anniversary of the "Belt and Road" Initiative

The forum aims mutual cooperation of countries along the "Belt and Road" in Asia, and provides a platform to promote high-quality development of the "Belt and Road" Initiative.

We are happy to invite academics from over the world to submit their scholarly work on the following sub- themes:

- 1. The Ancient 'Silk Road'
- 2. "Belt and Road" and Asia
- 3. Educational and cultural exchanges under the background of "One Belt One Road"
- 4. Economic and trade cooperation under the perspective of the "Belt and Road"
- 5. Cooperation and mutual learning of Confucius Institutes in countries along the "Belt and Road"

## **Guidelines for submission:**

- 1. Your abstract must be in English, between 300-350 words
- 2. The abstract should carry up to 5 keywords
- 3. The abstract should be formatter in Times New Roman size 12 with 1.5 line spacing
- 4. Standard abbreviations of SI units should be used
- 5. The abstract should include the purpose and background of the research, a brief description of research methods, findings, and conclusions.
- 6. Submit a stamp size (color) profile photo of yourself in JPG/PNG format.

Deadline for submissions: 10<sup>th</sup> September, 2023. Please prepare to do a 10 minute PowerPoint presentation of your research.

Important information to authors

- The full paper of your abstract is not compulsory. Those who prefer to send in a full paper in addition to the abstract may do so according to the following guidelines
  - The full paper should not exceed 2000 words.
  - The full paper should include Background, Objectives, Research Design/Materials and Methods, Results/ Findings, Conclusions and References.
  - References should follow the APA format.
  - The full paper should be in Times New Roman size 12, with 1.5 line spacing.
  - The document size should be A4 with a margin of 1 inch from top, bottom, right, and left.
- If sent, full papers will be published in the Colombo Journal for Chinese Studies (CJCS)
- All submissions received on or before the deadline will have the chance of being published in the Forum Proceedings.
- Late submissions will appear ONLY in the soft copy (PDF) of the Forum Proceedings and NOT in the printed copy.
- This forum is free of charge and authors do not have to pay for registration.
- For those who wish to participate onsite, the organizers will provide the following:
  - Accommodation and food for 1 night (\*Please note that you will have to fund your accommodation and food charges for the rest of your stay)
  - Pick up and Drop off at the airport
  - Support and guidance with the visa application process (\*Please note that CIUC will NOT be paying the air ticket prices to and from)
